## Stranger Danger

It has come to our attention in the past week that there have been a couple occasions when a car has approached some of our students on their way home. While both appear to be unrelated, I have contact SAPOL to inform them of the two incidents.

This is an opportune time to remind your child about talking to strangers if they are approached.

Some points you may wish to discuss:

- \* Don't speak with a stranger
- \* Don't approach a stranger's car
- \* Always tell a trusted adult if you have been approached by a stranger
- \* Move away from the source of danger as fast as you can (possibly head back to school)
- \* Walk in groups
- \* Stay on main roads and don't take short cuts
- \* Make sure your parents know where you are going and when you will be back (if your plans change be sure to tell your parents)
- \* If you have a phone, ring the police on 131444 or 000.

Please do not leave your dog tethered to a pole. While you know your dog well and feel it is safe to approach, others may not. When dogs remain tied to a pole you are eliminating their flight response, leaving only fight.

- \* Complete a Police Screening check
- \* Undertake appropriate induction training, if required.

Volunteers will be assessed for their suitability to work at the School by the Principal/ Nominee. This assessment is made in relation to the skills and contributions being offered and only after verification of the person's good character. The Principal/ Nominee's decision in determining eligibility to work as a volunteer at St Peter's Woodlands Grammar School is final.

Those students leaving the school grounds early are to be collected from the classroom by an adult after the adult has signed the student out at the Front Office. Students are not permitted to wait on the footpath or in the car park."

### SPW Car Park off Partridge Street

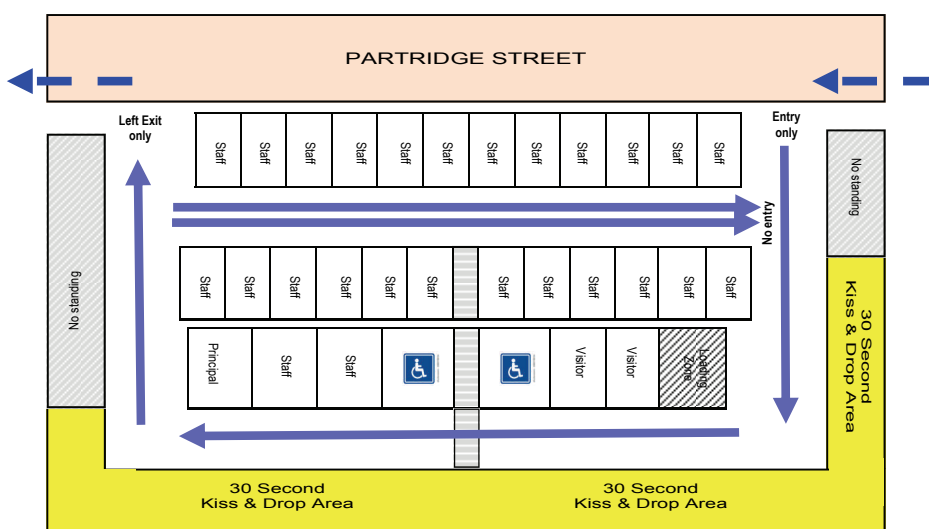
As of Monday 10 August, parking in the Partridge Street car park will be restricted to permit parking only, with minimal vacancies for visitors, disabled parking and loading zone. This decision has been made in order to improve the safety of this area, particularly at the beginning and end of the school day. To facilitate this process, we have new line marking, with improved signage, making it clear that:

- a. there is permit parking only, and
- b. Kiss and Drop zones are 30 second stop zones only.

### Making the Partridge Street Kiss & Drop Zone Safer

- Enter the Partridge Street car park as left turn only from Partridge Street.
- Avoid straddling the bike lane and footpath, when entering Partridge Street (hence avoiding traffic infringements).
- Exit Partridge Street, left turn only.
- **When entering SPW grounds, drive on solid blue line and keep rotating until you see your child ready to be picked up.**
- The pick up zone is marked yellow and is a 30 second Kiss and Drop zone only.
- Please instruct your children to stay on the Chapel steps and watch for your car, so that they are ready to be picked up from this yellow zone.
- DO NOT PARK AND WAIT IN THE KISS & DROP ZONE
- Children should not be picked up if your car is on the blue rotating line.
- Please observe the car park markings for Disabled, Visitor, Staff and Loading zone parks.

The above instructions apply during the hours of 8.00am and 4.00pm.
